# **Aviso**

The ultimate goal is to create an app that connects people from the same college class to:

- 1. Get help on questions include a reward system where individuals receive karma points when they help other individuals; make a leaderboard
- 2. Organize study sessions a poll and calendar system
- 3. Talk with individuals who previously attended the course have role categories: 'currently taking the course,' 'previously took the course,' and even a 'professor' category.

The idea is to make this exclusive to each college; for example, one will require an <u>emory.edu</u> address to join Emory College's class channels and see leaderboards.

# Creating an account

- 1. 'What college are you currently attending?'
- Provide an email address to confirm (verification with university email)
- 3. Notify them that the username will be the first section of the email address
- 4. 'Are you a current student, learning assistant, or teaching assistant' (from select option)
- 5. If the option is teaching or learning assistant, what class are you assisting?
- 6. 'What classes are you currently enrolled in?' (Select at least one from the course catalog provided; allow skip only if teaching assistant)
- 7. Notification settings, etc
- 8. The account is set up

## App layout


1. A home, notifications, and profile page



## **Home Page**

- 2. The home page contains three threads: 'All,' 'Study Group, 'Questions,' where 'All' contains everything from every tag. Under these threads will be the option to select 'All time,' 'Week', and 'Today' questions
- When posting from the home page, include two required tags:
- 'Questions,' 'Study Group,' or 'Misc' (all 'Misc,' 'Questions, and 'Study Group' tags go into the 'All' feed, while all 'Questions' tags go into the question feed, and all the 'Study Group' tags go into the 'Study Group' feed
- What class is this for? (bubble of all individual's enrolled classes)
- Allow image upload option

All in all, similar but different from this screenshot:



- How do we filter between classes in the home option? Have some form of a filter option on the home page for classes (don't know how to implement it yet without it being clanky). Maybe slide through options underneath the word "questions"
- For people to reply to questions, let the user swipe right to a post to reply; this will, at the same time, create a thread (where people can click on the post and see replies and ongoing conversations on the question)
- Let the reply option contain camera access and photo library access to attach a photo with text
- Allow people to re-reply (notifications will notify an individual of a re-reply). Question: How do we make it clear who replied to whom? Do we offset
- Add how long ago a post was made
- Allow the option to save posts (with their replies)
- Users will post under the study group with a specific repeating or non-repeating date, time, and place. Users on the page can sign up for however many slots the original creator decides to have. You can view everyone's names in the group. LAs can organize their study sessions like this. The advantage of using this app is that you know how many people will be attending and you can communicate with the entire class quickly rather than waiting for physical class.

Question: how should we navigate online study groups. Email them automatically for zoom link?

### **Notifications Page**

Notifications of replies to your post and comments.

## **Profile Page**

- Displays reputation points, posts created, replies, and reputation leaderboard
- DMs on the top right corner of the profile page
- Saved posts go on the profile page

# **Reputation system**

- Place an individual's reputation points next to their username
- Asking a question should give you a set default amount of reputation points
- Answering a question should give you a certain amount of reputation points based on individual voting on how well a question was answered
  - How do we get people to vote? What is the voting system?
- Limit to 20 questions a day for spam reputation point questions not to be an issue
- Leaderboard in profile section
- Awards system (e.g., 'you asked 50 questions all time!' award)
