
Flow Diagram – User Flow

The users who will visit the website or the mobile apps will have the following set of features for them to explore and access.

1. Landing Page (Only for website)

- This will be the main landing page where users can view the following details:

- 5. Features after registration
- As users register into the website and application they will view extra features like:

6. Search Icon/Bar

- Customers can search for any particular product of any category or sub-category in the search bar.

 - o View product listing on the screen
- 7. Filter and Sort Products
 - Filter products by: Price/city/brand/size/color
 - Sort by: latest products/price low to high or high to low
- 8. Products Listing
- All the products will be listed in any type of category or sub-category. The customer will first select any category and then a sub-category(if any) to view the product listing.

 - Name & thumbnail image only
 - View list of sub-categories (if any)
 - Name & thumbnail image only
 - Select a sub-category
 - View list of products

9. Product Details screen/page

- Here users can view more details of the products such as:

10. Seller Profile

- When a user clicks on a seller profile they can view:
 - List of all the ads posted by the user to date
 - o Image
 - o Name

 - No. of following
 - Follow (button)

11. Message Seller Feature

- As soon as the buyer messages the seller, the message screen will be categorized into two sections:
 - Chat
 - Here both users (buyer & seller) can chat using text & images only.

- Make Offer
 - When buyers select this option, they have to enter a price of their choice.
 - When the seller finds the price suitable, they will approve/confirm the price.
 - \circ The buyer can then make the payment at the mutually approved price.

12. Cart Page/Screen

- When a buyer clicks on **add to cart (button)**, the product will be added to the cart.
- Customers can only buy a single product in a cart at a time.
 - Product Name
 - Image
 - Location
 - View Cost
 - Delete/remove the product Continue (button)

13. Order Summary Page/Screen

- Buyers can view the summary of the order that will be placed:
 - View order summary
 - o Total order cost
 - Payable amount

Continue(button)

- On clicking the continue (button), the user will be taken to the address screen, where they have to select the delivery address:
 - View list of all the added address
 - o Select an address from the list
 - Edit(button)
 - Users can make changes to the current listed address
 - Add address(button)
 - Enter contact person no.
 - Enter phone no.
 - o Enter flat/house no.
 - Enter street name
 - Enter city
 - Select State
 - Enter Pincode
 - OR
 - Select from the Google Place Picker (<u>https://bit.ly/3rBj6zJ</u>)
 Save & continue(button)
 - Once the address is selected, the user will be taken to the choose **payment screen**, from where users will make the payment.
 - Payment gateway integration <u>https://stripe.com/ae/pricing</u> (Stripe Payment Gateway) **NOTE:** Payment will be split between the seller and the admin.

14. Payment Screen

- As users click on confirm & pay (button), they will be directed to the payment screen/page where they will enter the card details:
 - Enter card holder's name
 - Enter card no.
 - Enter expiry date
 - Enter CVV no.
 - Make Payment (button)

15. Order Confirmation

- Once the payment is made, the **order will be placed.** Here user will view the **order confirmation** with the order id.

16. Post An Ad/ Sell

- This will be a section from which the users will be able to post an ad for selling a product in such a manner-
 - Ad title
 - Select category
 - Select sub-category
 - Enter the Price for selling
 - Enter a long description (text only)
 - Enter cost
 - Add photos (Maximum 5)
 - Enter tag
 - Enter location
 - Add bank details
 - Enter bank name
 - Enter the account holder's name
 - o Enter branch
 - Enter bank code
 - Enter account no.

Submit (button)

- As soon as the seller submits the ad, the product will be sent to admin for verification.
- Once verified then only the product will be listed on the portal.
 NOTE: When a seller ads another product, the bank details will not be asked again to add.

17. My Ads

- Here the seller can view all the listed ads on the portal.
 - List of products
 - o Name
 - o Image
 - Posted date
 - o Cost

- Featured (only if the boost is purchased)
- Status (pending/approved)
- Product Detailing
 - Category
 - Sub-category
 - o Text description

18. Boost Products

- When a seller selects this option, the system will ask for:
 - Boost for a day
 - o View price
 - o Buy Now (button)
 - Boost for 2 days
 - \circ View price
 - Buy now (button)
 - Boost for a week
 - View price
 - Buy now (button)
- On clicking the buy now (button), the user will be asked to make a payment.
- Once the payment is made, the ad will be featured for a particular period.
- The seller can boost each product individually.

- This feature will be categorized into two sections
